

**POTOMAC INTERCEPTOR-LONG TERM ODOR ABATEMENT PROJECT
OLD ANGLER'S INN-MACARTHUR BOULEVARD (POTOMAC, MD)**

OVERVIEW

As part of a region wide effort to improve the quality and durability of sewers throughout the Washington Metropolitan Area, DC Water will be joining Loudon, Fairfax and Montgomery Counties in the construction of six facilities throughout the District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia that will work as a system in collectively helping to reduce odors emitting from the Potomac Interceptor Sewer, as well as prolong the life of the pipeline.

One of the specific odor abatement facilities for this project will be located on MacArthur Boulevard in Potomac, Maryland, adjacent to the Old Angler's Inn. As the building will sit on property owned jointly by the National Park Service (NPS) and US Army Corps of Engineers-Washington Aqueduct Division (WAD), DC Water has worked closely with both agencies to develop a design that will have minimal impact on the site. SCOPE OF WORK

This project involves the construction of an odor abatement facility adjacent to the Old Angler's Inn located on MacArthur Boulevard in Potomac, Maryland. Once completed, the new facility's design will include the following elements:

- Dimension of approximately 45 feet (length) x 48 feet (width)
- Uniform in design with surrounding buildings and structures
- Public restrooms that will be owned and operated by the NPS for visitors to the C & O Canal National Historic Park
- Paved parking for visitors to the park

SCHEDULE

- Construction start: April 2010
- Construction completion: December 2012
- Normal work hours: 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Contractor may work at night or on weekends, dependent upon needed tie-in work or inclement weather

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The construction of the odor abatement facility will generate certain levels of noise and vibration. These will be closely monitored.

TRAFFIC

- There will be reduced parking in the park area near the Old Angler's Inn during construction.
- Construction traffic, including trucks, will be accessing the work site. (See attached map)

PARTNERS

DC Water is currently working closely with various local civic groups and is also coordinating with the WAD, Montgomery County, the NPS and other federal agencies to ensure minimal disruption during this project.

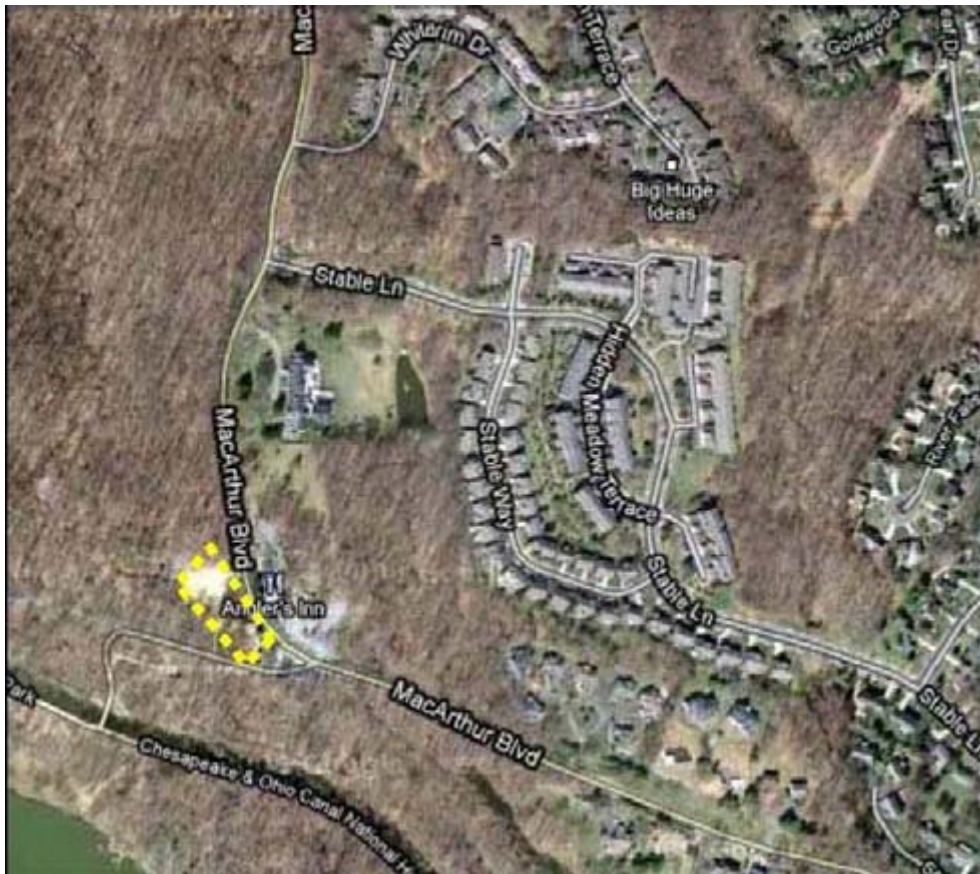
