

ROCK CREEK SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT CSO 037

OVERVIEW

The Rock Creek Sewer Separation Project is an activity of DC Water's Long Term Control Plan (LTCP). The LTCP is required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to reduce pollution from combined sewer overflows (CSOs) to Rock Creek and the Anacostia and Potomac rivers. As part of the LTCP, DC Water is required to separate single combined sewers into separate sanitary and storm sewers for the drainage basins serving four specific overflow locations.

One of the specific drainage basins for this project is CSO 037, which consists of 15.5 acres of single family residences and foreign missions. The area is currently served by an existing combined sewer system which collects surface runoff, roof drainage and sanitary flow.

The work will occur along the following streets: Belmont Road NW; Kalorama Road NW; Tracy Place NW; Wyoming Avenue NW; and Kalorama Circle NW. (See back page for proposed construction location map)

SCOPE OF WORK

Work to be performed by DC Water will include the following:

- Installation of approximately 3,500 feet of new storm sewers
- Rehabilitation of over 850 feet of existing sewer infrastructure within the affected area of sewer line
- Replacement of over 3,600 feet of water mains and valves along neighborhood streets, as well as existing lead service pipes and fire hydrants needing repair or replacement
- Restoration of the project site

SCHEDULE

- Construction start: June 2009
- Construction completion: fall 2011
- Normal work hours: 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Contractor may work at night or on weekends, dependent upon needed tie-in work or inclement weather

TRAFFIC

- At various times during construction, "no-parking" signs may need to be placed in certain areas in and around the job site. Notifications regarding "no-parking" zones will be posted 72 hours prior to construction, as required by the District Department of Transportation (DDOT).
- During work hours, street parking within the project area will be restricted.

PARTNERS

DC Water is currently working closely with the National Park Service (NPS), District Department of the Environment (DDOE) and other District and federal agencies to ensure minimal disruption during this project. DC Water will also coordinate with Advisory Neighborhood Commissions, environmental and community associations, and individual property owners to provide regular updates throughout the project.

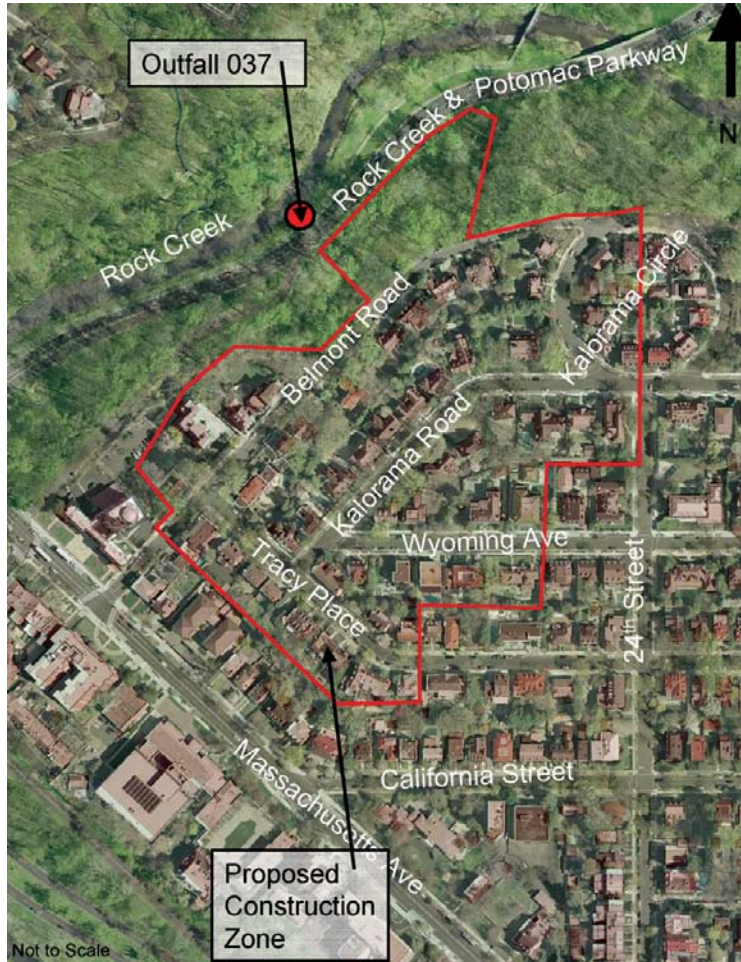
