QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Inquiry No. 1

Question:

I would like to request clarification on the submission categories. If a proposed project is managing right-of-way runoff on a publicly-owned (or government-owned) parcel, would that be considered a Public Space project or a Government/Institution project? Does one category supersede the other or would it be up to our discretion as to which category to submit to?

Answer:

The submission should be entered in the category where the Green Infrastructure practice is sited.

2. Inquiry No. 2

Question:

Regarding the Organizational Structure submission requirement: Please clarify, is that intended to convey the team members participating in the Planning and Design component, or the planning and design through construction component, or more generally the organizational structure of the participating firms on the submission?

Answer:

The Organization Structure submission component should include the requested information in the GI Challenge Briefing Document for the team members that are part of the Planning and Design phase. If team members have been identified for the Construction phase they may be included as well but are not required to be identified at this time.
