1. Tunnel Safety Officer **NEW**

Description: The Tunnel Safety Officer performs and documents job site inspections and audits. Reports to the Tunnel Safety Manager and is expected to work in tunnel environments. Monitors compliance with occupational health standards and use of personal protection equipment. Participates in internal safety reviews, site inspections, and incident investigations.

MUST: Have 3+ years' tunnel experience

MUST: Be a certified Construction and Health Safety Technician or can immediately take and pass the exam

MUST: Have OSHA 30 training (*MSHA training accepted in lieu of OSHA training*)

MUST: Be able to write reports

MUST: Be able to read and interpret safety regulations

MUST: Be able to work any shift

MUST: Have a High School Diploma/GED

MUST: Have a valid driver's license

2. Yard/Warehouse Associate

Description: Associates receives and inspects materials, unload trucks, and transports to designated locations. Prepares fence products for upcoming jobs including notching/cutting/bending pipe, etc. using simple machinery and hand tools. Rotates yard stock and moves materials as needed while maintaining yard inventory so stock is stored properly to eliminate damaging materials. Performs minor repairs and maintenance of equipment/tools. Ensures warehouse and yard are clean and organized at all times. Maintains product stock in the warehouse and assist in inventory counts. Performs additional duties as assigned by the team leader. Safely operates a forklift, certification a plus but not required. May be asked to drive a company vehicle. **Job site in Jessup, MD.**

MUST: Have a High School Diploma/GED

MUST: Have a clean driving record

MUST: Have 1+ years' Construction, Warehouse and/or Yard experience

3. Laborer/ CDL Drivers Class A or Class B

Description: Drivers operate standard and automatic transmission Straight Trucks. The contractor will also have specialized equipment that will require additional company-facilitated Cured in Place Pipes (CIPP) training. Other duties include: Executing point repairs, all restorations (asphalt/sod, etc.). Locates and prepares manholes, executes all punch list work, excavates by hand and with track hoe or excavator. Secures pits and shoring work, breaks and repairs manholes. Work conditions include confined space and inclement weather. **Job site in Beltsville, MD.**

MUST: Have a current CDL Class A/Class B

MUST: Have a clean driving history with minimal points

MUST: Have 6+ months driving experience

MUST: Communicate effectively and work well with a team

**Tanker/Hazmat endorsements preferred but not required*

4. Traffic Control Personnel/Flagger

Description: This position performs traffic control and flagging activities as needed; including placing signs, barricades, traffic cones, and other warning devices. Duties may vary according to job assignment. Operates pickup and flatbed trucks (not requiring a commercial driver's license), and miscellaneous hand tools in accordance with all safety regulations and procedures. Conducts routine equipment maintenance and daily equipment inspections. Performs basic road repair and maintenance tasks. Reports safety hazards and traffic problems to Foreman/Crew Leader. Performs manual labor tasks as needed. Cuts brush areas with hand tools, chips, loads and hauls brush, clears right-of-way of debris to improve visibility and diminish road hazards. May be exposed to inclement weather. Observes OSHA safety rules and regulations, and safety standards in hazardous traffic environments. Prepares reports and maintains records. Responds to emergencies as directed and performs tasks in the interest of public safety and property protection during emergencies.

MUST: Have a High School Diploma/GED

MUST: Have 1+ years' construction or traffic control experience

MUST: Be 18 years of age or older

MUST: Have a valid Traffic Control Flagger's card (**ATSSA** Traffic Control Flagger's card preferred)

MUST: Complete the company's First Aid/CPR training programs

- MUST:** Be able to pass a drug screening and background check
- MUST:** Be able to lift and move items weighing up to fifty (50) pound
- MUST:** Have a valid driver's license

5. Concrete Pump Truck Driver with CDL Class B

Description: Operates Concrete Pump Trucks. Training is provided, and benefits are available after 90 days' employment. **Job site in Laurel, MD.**

- MUST:** Have a valid CDL Class B
- MUST:** Have a High School Diploma/GED
- MUST:** Have reliable transportation

6. CDL Class A Driver

Description: Driver provides delivery of crushed stone, cement, sand, gravel, recycled products, and topsoil to customers' job site. Also, provides pick-up and disposal of non-hazardous soil and concrete. Performs pre-and post-trip vehicle inspections. Strictly adheres to safety requirements and procedures as outlined in the Employee Handbook. **Knowledge of DC/MD area a plus.**

- MUST:** Have 1+ years' Dump Truck/Tractor Trailer experience
- MUST:** Speak, read, and write English
- MUST:** Be able to work 40+ hrs. per week
- MUST:** Be able to work with little supervision

7. Yardman/Mechanic Helper

Description: This job entails lifting, operating yard equipment, delivering parts to job sites, picking up parts for mechanics, organizing inventory items, keeping the yard clean, assisting with shop repairs, and maintenance as needed. Benefits are available after 90 days of employment. **Job site in Laurel, MD.**

- MUST:** Have a valid driver's license
 - MUST:** Have reliable transportation
 - MUST:** Have a High School Diploma/GED
- *Forklift and Sweeper experience, a plus*

8. CDL Class B Driver

Description: Performing industrial maintenance cleaning work, including vacuuming industrial wastes/materials (solids, sludges, and liquids) and water blast cleaning various surfaces. Must read and write English; enabling employees to complete the job-related paperwork necessary for billing/payroll purposes, document truck inspections, read maps/ directions to the job site, read safety warnings, etc. Benefits package available and salary will be determined based on experience. **Job sites in Beltsville, and Baltimore MD. Must be able to occasionally travel out-of-state.**

- MUST:** Have a valid Class B CDL or CDL B Learner's Permit (Candidates with CDL B Learner's Permit will be required to obtain a Class B CDL within a time frame set forth by the contractor)
- MUST:** Have previous outdoor labor, driving, transportation and construction experience
- MUST:** Have a High School Diploma/GED
- MUST:** Have reliable transportation

9. TV Tech Laborer/Tap Cutter with (CDL Class B)

Description: Duties include but not limited to: Utilize remote cameras and CCTV equipment to videotape inside sewer lines for inspections. Determines whether cleaning and/or repairs are needed; reinstatement of service laterals after rehabilitation (cutting taps) when needed. Services, adjusts, and performs minor repairs to cameras and equipment. Learns CIPP products and processes, safety procedures, and installation techniques. Work in confined spaces. Drives various vehicles, from pickups to tractor-trailer rigs, to haul crews and equipment. Ability to travel is required. **Job site in Arbutus, MD.**

MUST: Have a High School Diploma/GED

MUST: Have 2+ years' experience in trenchless installation, including robotic tap cutting

MUST: Have a Class B CDL w/Airbrake Endorsement, or be able to obtain within 90 days of hire

MUST: Be able to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals

MUST: Be able to comprehend instructions accurately to learn CIPP products, processes, safety procedures, installation techniques, and equipment use

**NASSCO PACP and MACP Certifications are a plus.*

10. Construction Rehab Laborer with CDL (Class B with Airbrakes)

Description: Works successfully with supervisors and peers on various water and sewer rehabilitation and repair projects. Performs job site setup and cleanup, hauls equipment and crew members by driving various vehicles, including tractor-trailers. Guides and assists crew members with equipment adjustments and alignment, based on project and location needs, completes driver's daily record of duty, submits work orders for vehicle and equipment maintenance, as needed. Cuts lines for installation by entering manholes. Reads and reviews work and entry permits. Continuously monitors for Safety hazards and reports any safety issues to the supervisor. **Ability to travel is required, as much as 90%. Job site in Arbutus, MD.**

MUST: Have a High School Diploma/GED

MUST: Have 2+ years' experience working in an outdoor construction environment

MUST: Work effectively in confined spaces

MUST: Possess a Class B CDL w/Airbrakes or be able to obtain such license within 60 days of employment

MUST: Read/interpret all construction rules, manuals, and other documents

MUST: Learn and follow company procedures and policies, including safety rules and regulations, proper use of equipment, and correct installation techniques

MUST: Pass driver's license check for last 5 years without any suspensions or major traffic violations

MUST: Be able to lift, carry, and haul up to 75 pounds

11. CDL Driver (Class A with Hazmat and Tanker Endorsements)

Description: Drivers are responsible for transporting different types of materials to locations using company trucks. Drivers also follow appropriate safety procedures to transport hazardous materials and unload cased products from the trailer as needed. Drivers are required to perform inspections before and after trips and maintain logs of vehicle repair status and working hours. **Job sites in Fairfax, VA, and Baltimore, MD.**

MUST: Have 2+ years' verifiable Tractor Trailer experience

MUST: Have or be able to obtain TWIC and DOT medical card

MUST: Be able to provide a current driving record

12. Diesel Mechanic (2nd and 3rd Shift)

Description: Repairs and maintains diesel engines for trucks using hand tools, precision measuring instruments, and machines. Job sites in DC, MD, and VA.

MUST: Be able to handle the company's high volume of work

MUST: Be available when emergencies occur with the trucks

MUST: Be DOT certified for Brakes and Federal PM Inspections

13. Heavy Truck Technician (Class A CDL with Airbrake Endorsement)

Description: Inspects, repairs, and maintains refrigeration systems. Conducts daily inspections of the fleet to ensure vehicles are in good working order. Responds to road emergencies to repair vehicles as necessary. **Job sites in DC, MD, and VA.**

MUST: Be able to work in non-climate-controlled conditions.

MUST: Have 2+ years' practical experience with heavy trucks and equipment

MUST: Be ASE certified

14. Armed Security Officers

Description: Ensures the facility is provided with high-quality security services to protect people and property.
