1. Cement Mason

Description: Duties include: coaching and hands-on training to general laborers or trainees on proper technique and form. *(Exposed to all weather conditions including very hot and very cold weather. Exposed to loud noise)*

MUST: Have a minimum of 2 years' experience in forming and finishing concrete at construction work sites.

MUST: Have strong knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the work being performed.

MUST: Have strong verbal communication skills.

Subject to background check; drug and alcohol screening.

2. Skilled Concrete Laborer

Description: Looking to hire an experienced Heavy Highway Concrete Skilled Laborer.

Duties include but are not limited to: handling construction materials, leveling and finishing freshly poured concrete, setting up and tearing down work sites.

MUST: Have a minimum of 2 years' experience with Concrete in Heavy Highway Construction.

3. Pipe-Layers

MUST: Have a valid driver's license.

MUST: Have at least one year of experience as a Pipe-layer.

4. Ecological Engineer

Description: Resources specialist needed to support design and permitting efforts for stream restoration, living shorelines, wetland creation, and habitat restoration projects. Duties will include but are not limited to: watershed delineation and characterization, hydrologic and hydraulic analysis and modeling, drafting of technical and engineering reports, permit preparation and submittal.

MUST: Have MS in water resources, biological systems, environmental, civil engineering or equivalent.

MUST: Have professional Maryland Engineer's License.

MUST: Have minimum 3 years' of experience in this industry.

MUST: Have an understanding of ecological processes.

MUST: Have hydrologic and hydraulic modeling skills.

MUST: Have drafting and mapping skills. (Civil 3D, ArcMap, etc.)

MUST: Have strong technical writing and oral presentation capabilities.

- MUST:** Have familiarity with permit submittal and review. (Local, State, and Federal)

5. Hydro-seeding Foreman

- MUST:** Have CDL Class A driving license.
 - Must:** Have clean driving record.
 - Must:** Be able to pass a background check and a drug test.
 - Must:** Be able to effectively, safely, and positively manage and direct a crew of 2 laborers
 - Must:** Be able to complete paperwork in a timely, clear fashion (*Paperwork includes: time sheets, tracking sheets, safety report, and fertilizer reports etc.*)
 - Must:** Be professional fertilizer certified or the ability to pass the test to become a professional fertilizer.
 - Must:** Have understanding of seed, the seeding process, and soils or the ability to learn these subjects quickly.
 - Must:** Be able to effectively communicate with Superintendents, Owner's Inspectors, Prime Contractors, and/or Project Managers.

6. Concrete Pump Truck Drivers/Operators

- Description:** Duties include: controlling the operation of the pump and the output of concrete by directing the boom. Operator is responsible for getting the machine to and from the job site and making sure the pump is ready for the next job.
- MUST:** Have Class A or B CDL.
 - MUST:** Pass a drug test.
 - MUST:** Be able work a flexible schedule.
 - MUST:** Have 3-5 years' experience operating a concrete pump truck.
- *Willing to train the right person with CDL**

7. CDL Drivers—Class A (*driving slots open in Fairfax, VA and Baltimore, MD*)

- MUST:** Be 23 or older.
- MUST:** Have Hazmat & Tanker endorsement.
- MUST:** Have 2 years' of verifiable tractor trailer experience.
- MUST:** Have or be able to obtain TWIC card.
- MUST:** Have DOT medical card.
- MUST:** Have current driving record.

8. Diesel Mechanic (2nd and 3rd Shift)

- Description:** Repairs and maintains diesel engines for trucks using hand tools, precision measuring instruments, and machine tools.

9. Crane Operators (Hydraulic or Friction)
