WHEREAS, the Authority has provided water and sewer services to the properties located at 200 and 210 55th Street N.E. Washington, DC; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Ministry, Inc. purchased these properties approximately two years ago and is planning to build cooperative homes for teenage mothers currently in the foster care program; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Ministry, Inc. is working with the Department of Housing and Community Development and other agencies of the District of Columbia to rehabilitate these properties to provide a service to the public; and

WHEREAS, the property was vandalized while building rehabilitation plans were being made by the ministry resulting in the theft of copper pipes and other fixtures allowing water to run and flood the basement; and

WHEREAS, there were no drains or functioning sump pumps in the basement to discharge the water into the sewer system for treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Ministry, Inc. has incurred unexpected repair costs due to the damages caused by flooding and is unable to pay the outstanding water and sewer charges; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Ministry, Inc. is unable to obtain a construction loan due to water and sewer liens on the properties; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Ministry Inc. is requesting relief from paying the water and sewer charges; and

WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to waive Fifty Percent (50%) for the combined water usage of both properties, equaling Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$11,361.68) and One Hundred Percent (100%) sewer usage, equaling Thirty Four Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars and Four Cents (\$34,285.04) as well as all applicable fees, late charges and penalties of Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$11,848.68) for a total waiver of Fifty Seven Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Five dollars and Forty Cents (\$57,495.40); and
