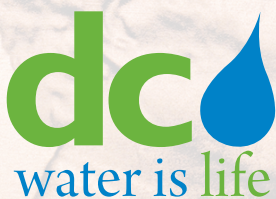


DC Water: Still about a penny a gallon.

Your water bill is changing. Starting this October 1, 2012, DC Water will increase rates to replace our water infrastructure faster and to keep up with federal mandates to protect the environment.

Even with the new rates, our bills are far lower than those of other utilities. Tap water is still a bargain and better for the earth than bottled.
