


# Do you have lead pipes?

# Save 50% to 100% on costs, on average \$2,500





The Lead Pipe Replacement **Assistance Program (LPRAP)** helps District residents replace lead service lines that connect the city water supply to their household plumbing.

- At some homes, the public portion of service pipe was replaced, though lead pipe remains on private property.
- All property owners with a lead pipe on private property and non-lead in public space can apply for a 50% discount.
- Some property owners will be eligible for 80% to 100% coverage depending on household size and income.

# Lead Pipe Replacement Assistance Program (LPRAP)

(for customers with lead pipe on private property, and non-lead pipe in public space)

## Why replace lead?

Lead pipes of any length can release lead into clean drinking water. Elevated lead levels can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and children.

## Do I qualify?

Every property owner with a lead pipe on private property and non-lead pipe in public space is eligible for a 50% discounted replacement. Some property owners will be eligible for 80% to 100% coverage depending on household size and income. Eligibility is determined by the Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE).

# How do I apply?

Customers can apply at **dcwater.com/lead-assist**. Residents seeking discounts of more than 50% will need to provide income verification documents. Property owners must provide a quote for proposed work by a DC-licensed plumber or contractor with application. Guidance for project work is available at **dcwater.com/LSR-guidelines**.

NOTE: Filter water used for drinking and cooking until all sources of lead have been removed. Ensure the filter is NSF-53 certified for lead removal.
