A. Continued tension between labor and management at DC Water:

- a. Labor Relations has implemented a negative strategy of management against the Unions and has sought to cut-off direct communication with managers, (the combative us against them strategy).
- b. Managers/supervisors and foreman have been told by Labor Relations not to talk to the Unions, (the combative us against them strategy).
- c. Managers are being told not to talk to the Unions about their inquiries or concerns, (part of the us against them strategy).

B. Advancing Blue Performance Management:

- a. DC Water has failed to provide the Union with information needed to prepare bargaining proposals.
- b. The Unions are requesting that the Board's HR Committee review and reevaluate the current program for specificity, fairness and equity to employees. There should not be one person who creates the program and changes the program without review by the HR Committee.
