

IDENTIFYING LEAD SERVICE PIPE

The home builder typically installs one type of pipe for the entire water service line. Observing the pipe that enters your home, either through the wall or basement floor, can indicate the pipe material of part or all of your service line.

What does your pipe look like entering your home? See attached fact sheet describing the different types of pipe material.





- Find the whole house water shut-off valve in the basement or lowest floor
