

LARGE DIAMETER SEWER CONDITION ASSESSMENT – WEST ROCK CREEK DIVERSION SEWER (WRCDS)

ROCK CREEK MULTI-USE TRAIL AND ROCK CREEK AND POTOMAC PARKWAY CLOSURE

OVERVIEW

As part of its regular program to inspect, evaluate, and rehabilitate sewers across the city, DC Water will be performing routine inspections of the West Rock Creek Diversion Sewer (WRCDS). The purpose of these inspections is to assess the current condition of designated sewers and determine whether maintenance or repair to the sewers will be needed to avoid potential future issues.

For this project location, there will be inspection of the large diameter sewer pipe along the Rock Creek Trail spanning north of Q Street Northwest to Pennsylvania Avenue Northwest.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Inspection of approximately 1,600 linear feet of sewer main using three (3) manholes for inspection access.

SCHEDULE

- Inspection Date: August 18, 2026
- Typical Working Hours: 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Work is anticipated to take 1-2 days depending on conditions and weather.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Inspections will be performed under normal flow conditions in the sewers and should not have any effect on area customers' sewer service.
- A structure along the Rock Creek Multi-use Trail will be used as an access point. The Rock Creek Multi-use Trail will need to be closed for public safety between P Street NW and Pennsylvania Avenue NW. A trail detour will be provided through Rose Park (see Page 2 figures). Work at this location will occur between the hours of 10:00 AM to 2:30 PM to avoid trail impacts during typical rush hour.
- DC Water's inspection contractor will need to place vehicles at two additional manholes for access to the sewer main. They are located south of the footbridge near Q Street NW and by the Pennsylvania Avenue NW on-ramp. No road or trail closures will occur at those locations.

TRAFFIC

- One lane of the Rock Creek and Potomac Pkwy NW (South Bound) between P Street and Pennsylvania Ave NW will be closed between the hours of 10:00 AM to 2:30 PM.

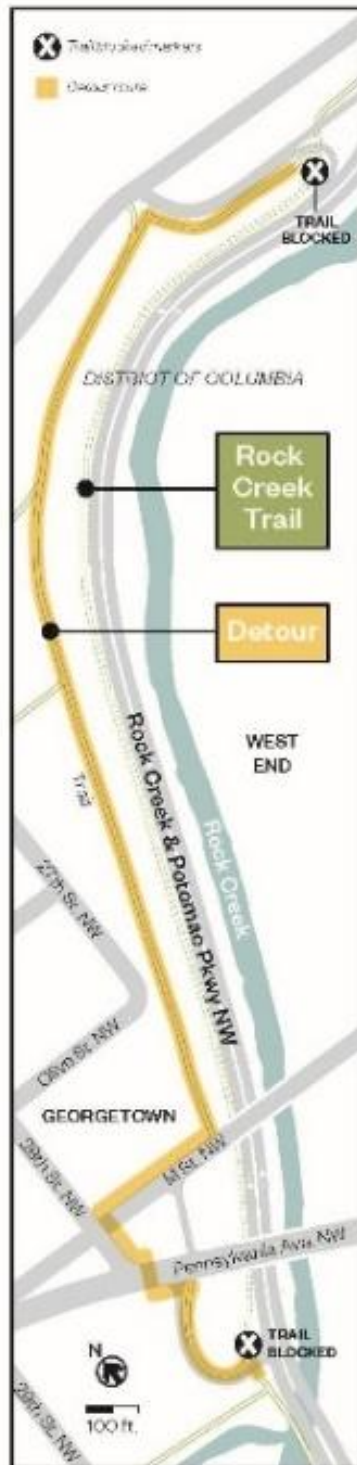
PARTNERS
